Position Summary:

The incumbent will support Pearson's International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (IBDP) curriculum that promotes creativity, activity and service (CAS). This experiential learning component is aimed at helping students discover causes and activities that matter to them and learn how to turn them into initiatives, projects and activities that can help others long after students have left the College. Outdoor activities encourage students to challenge themselves, promote activity and exercise as a crucial part of their school experience and provide an opportunity to explore the natural beauty of the region and interact with area residents.

Responsibilities:

 Provide participating students (ages 16-19) with dinghy sailing skills that support selfchallenge, achievement and environmental awareness appropriate to their age and level of skill and dinghy sailing experience.



- Work closely with the CAS Dinghy Sailing Supervisor to run the program on Tuesdays and Fridays (1400-1700) from September through December 2022 and January through April 2023.
- Liaise with the CAS Coordinator, Seafront Operations and Race Rocks Coordinator (SORRC) and Seafront Support and Activities Facilitator as necessary for dinghy maintenance and support.
- Provide for the proper care, rigging and handling of College dinghies.
- Exercise safe, competent operation of watercraft in the conduct of dinghy sailing instruction duties and student oversight/safety.
- Work closely with activity leaders and College seafront staff to coordinate successful execution of the dinghy sailing program, including student achievement of progressive learn to sail standards and CANSail certifications.
- Take an active role in supporting environmental awareness associated with dinghy sailing.
- Maintain excellent verbal and written communications and liaison with activity leaders, students and staff.

Qualifications & Experience

- CANSail 5/6 Dinghy Sailing Instructor preferred; CANSail 3/4 will be considered based on experience.
- Pleasure Craft Operator Card (PCOC).
- Marine Basic or Standard First Aid (must obtain within first 3 months of employment College will reimburse).
- Commitment to the growth and development of youth on an individual, group and societal level, compassion for people and for the health and sustainability of the environment.
- Ability to model effective and appropriate leadership style(s) and role model behavior in line with the values of Pearson and the United World College (UWC) movement.
- Comfortable working with young people from varied backgrounds, nationalities and cultures and ability to establish effective rapport with activity leaders, staff and students.
