Pearson College UWC was <u>founded</u> as Lester B. Pearson United World College of the Pacific (Canada) in 1974 and is one of 18 UWC (United World Colleges) schools <u>worldwide</u>. Located on the <u>traditional</u> <u>territory of the Sc'ianew (Beecher Bay) First Nation</u>, the Pearson campus is on Pedder Bay which adjoins the Salish Sea on the Pacific coast of British Columbia, Canada.

The College's mission – "to make education a force to unite people, nations and cultures for peace and a sustainable future" – is transformational. Pearson is a two-year pre-university (equivalent to grades 12 & 13) school for more than 200 leaders and changemakers aged 16 to 19 selected from up to 160 countries and all regions of Canada who live and learn together on campus. Most Pearson students, close to 80% annually, attend on full or partial scholarships made possible through individual and organizational donors.
