Position Summary:

The Student Transportation Coordinator oversees all aspects of student travel and ground transportation for off-campus activities and throughout College-sanctioned breaks. Along with working with the Operations team, the Coordinator will work closely with the College's staff & faculty, to support the needs of students and the College.

Major Responsibilities:

- Coordinates student air travel arrangements as required or as directed.
- Coordinates student ground transportation as required or as directed.
- Communicate travel plans to students effectively and in a timely manner.
- Respond to emergent issues and concerns by assessing the situation, identifying the most appropriate response, and recommending resources and assistance where appropriate.
- Assist with recruiting college drivers as needed and maintain a steady roster of drivers to meet transportation demands.
- Supervise college drivers.
- Keep track of driver's hours and prepare timesheets for payroll purposes twice a month.

- Effective communications skills, orally and in writing.
